474/P TRANSPORT MATTERS

The Committee received a Public Notice issued by Central Bedfordshire Council in respect of the introduction of waiting restrictions in Kestrel Way and Johnson Drive.

RESOLVED that the Town Council was in support of the proposals for waiting restrictions on Kestrel Way and Johnson Drive.

The Committee discussed issues with footpaths, as raised at the meeting held on 13 March 2019. A response from Central Bedfordshire Council suggested that issues regarding condition of footpaths be reported online via the portal for investigation. Committee members expressed views that the portal was not always easy or accurate to use, and that it had been understood in the past that Central Bedfordshire Council would be undertaking a town-wide footpath "suitability study".

A specific example of The Paddocks was given, where there was almost no level pavement due to tree roots. It was agreed to log this issue online.

The Committee suggested that a representative from Highways be asked to attend a future meeting, so that new Committee members could better understand how highways matters were dealt with and how issues should be logged.
