Standing Orders

Upon additional proof-reading, it has been identified that the following existing Standing Orders do not appear in the new NALC Model or in the draft document merging the two.

It is proposed that the following existing SO's **remain in place** and be included within the new SOs as outlined below.

This is therefore **no change** to existing SO's beyond a change in format/referencing.

| 1a | All Meetings of the Council shall be held at The White House at 1930 hours unless the Council decides otherwise at a previous meeting. | Retain | Add text to new SO 3a |
| 2j (iii) | In the ordinary year of election to the Council, to fill any vacancies left unfilled at the election by reason of insufficient nominations | Retain | Add text to new SO 5i |
| 2j(vii) | To elect a Councillor to be Leader of the Council | Retain | Add text to new SO 5j |
| 2j(viii) | To announce the Leaders and Deputy Leaders of the political groups represented on the Council | Retain | Add text to new SO 5j |
| 2j(ix) | To receive announcements from the Group Leaders of the Council | Retain | Add text to new SO 5j |
| 2j(xii) | Review and confirm the number of members and representation by each of the political groups for each Committee | Retain | Add text to new SO 5j |
| 6c | If a member of a political party or an independent Councillor moves a motion or a resolution where that member is the sole representative of that party, the motion or resolution shall be deemed to have been automatically seconded. | Retain | Add text to new SO 1 |
| 6f | No speech by a mover of a resolution shall exceed 10 minutes | Retain | Add text to new SO 1 |
| 6v | The adjournment of a debate or a meeting shall not prejudice the mover's right of reply at the resumption. | Retain | Add text to new SO 1s |
| 29c | A councillor's failure to observe standing orders more than three times in any one meeting may result in him/her being excluded from the meeting. | Retain | Add text to new SO 26 |
