Advertisement 1

Facia sign measuring 1040mm square, made from digital print onto aluminium. Colour as per image shown below on white background.

Sign to be mounted on brick wall at front of kiosk (1800mm to right of serving window), 1 meter above the ground, using heavy duty screws. See image on page 2.



Advertisement 2

White Notice Board with locked glass cover measuring 1170mm (W) x 1040mm (H) to be used to display menus, and other information about the Café. Notice Board to be mounted on brick wall at front of kiosk (300mm to right of serving window), 1 meter above the ground, using heavy duty screws. See image on page 2.



Advertisement 3

Facia sign measuring 1830mm (W) x 915mm (H), made from digital print onto aluminium. Colour as per image shown below.

Sign to be mounted on brick wall underneath the serving hatch at front of kiosk, 75mm above the ground, using heavy duty screws. See image below.

Advertisement 4

4x Café in the Park Feather Banners to be displayed outside the kiosk when it is open to the public.

2x Beechdean Dairy Ice Cream Feather Banners to be displayed outside the kiosk when it is open to the public (April to October).

1x Beechdean Swing Sign for use outside the kiosk.



Advertisement 6

2x Beechdean mini flag fixed to the side of the kiosk, one to the left of the door/shutter and one to the right of the window/shutter (see photo below) at 1.9 meters above ground level.



Advertisement 7

6 x Street Banners measuring 1830mm (W) x 915mm (H) made of digital print on to heavy duty PVC.

Banners to be displayed on railings in and around the centre of Leighton Buzzard and in Parson's Close Recreation Ground for up to two months at a time (April to May) and (July to August) in order to promote the opening of the Café. As it is a new venue we need to promote its existence but understand that CBC does not like street banners up indefinitely or without the relevant planning permission. We will act responsibly and will erect them safely and remove all cable ties used to affix banners to the railings.

We have the permission of Leighton-Linslade Town Council to erect banners in Parson's Close Recreation Ground. We are seeking the permission of CBC (through this planning application) to erect banners on its railings on the highway.
