TOWN CENTRE PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM

The Corporate Governance Manager has met with two companies who offered to provide an estimated cost for the installation of a Town Centre Public Address system. One of these companies, decided not to provide any further information.

The remaining company did provide an estimated cost which is within the allocated budget of £25,000.

Following this estimation, the Corporate Governance Manager has provided Central Bedfordshire Council's Conservation Officer with the design specification of the speakers, these would need to be installed to the front of buildings, to obtain some advice and guidance – awaiting his response.

Any work to these buildings would need permission from the owners by way of a wayleave - there are ten speakers to be installed.

Members are requested to consider whether they wish to proceed with the tender process for this project (subject to satisfactory acceptance by the Conservation Officer). The Corporate Governance Manager has given an overview to interested companies of what is required, however, Council employees are not technically qualified to provide detailed specifications within the tender document.

Recommendation to note the report and to consider the next steps.
