FAIRTRADE SIGNAGE

1 Update on Signage Costs

- 1.1 Bedfordshire Highways has now advised of more accurate costings for signage :

Fair trade signs: £850 per sign. Number of signs required TBC

This includes the following :

- New Fair trade signs
- New posts and concrete bases
- Existing town nameplate signs to be re-used and re-mounted onto the new posts

This is a very rough estimate; it may be possible to re-use some of the existing posts however until each location has been visited and the posts measured / condition checked this cannot be determined.

Traffic management will need to be added where appropriate when the locations of where these signs are to be mounted have been identified, although some can be done without any traffic management, particularly if the existing posts are to be re-used. Some may need some traffic management if the current location is on a relatively narrow verge / outside of the 30mph limit, again to be determined when each site is visited.

- 1.2 Tourist signs on the bypass: £ 8,650 per sign. Number of signs required TBC.

This includes the following:

- New tourist sign 11m² based on sign Diag. 2328, x-height 200
- Lattix posts and concrete bases
- Traffic Management

Again this is a very rough estimate; as a location for these signs has not been identified, the Traffic Management may need to be amended and it will be necessary to determine a suitable location where each of these signs will fit.
