Town Council/Partnership Strategic Objectives for 2011-2015

- Promote projects in Big Plan II *Reviewed during 2012-13 by Big Plan Projects Sub-Committee; projects now underway through Partnership Committee*
- Explore the possibility of producing a Neighbourhood Plan. *Resolved Dec 2014 not to proceed*
- Review and utilise, wherever possible, Section 106 monies for the delivery of infrastructure as identified in Leighton-Linslade Big Plan II. *Negotiations ongoing with CBC.*
- Embrace the emerging Central Bedfordshire Council Town Centre Development Briefs; support and encourage new initiatives to improve the vitality and viability of Leighton Buzzard and Linslade town centres. *Update given from CBC October 2012.*
- Engage with the existing business community to seek ways to accelerate growth; encourage new businesses to locate in Leighton-Linslade. *Economic Development Sub-Committee established; business networking events held 2013 & 2014; initiatives such as Summer Sundays and Temporary Beach to attract people in to the town centre*
- Support the provision of sporting and recreational facilities at Astral Park for the benefit of the wider community. *Astral Park building now open, offering diverse activities including private function hire; football to move to Astral Park from summer 2014.*
- Support the Station Travel Plan and work in partnership on major transport and parking issues. *Ongoing.*

What we hope to achieve in 2014-15

- Support Central Bedfordshire Council's Economic Development Plan, in relation to Leighton-Linslade *Projects agreed*
- Consider, propose and promote projects which encourage greater economic development in Leighton-Linslade
- Review and develop town centre strategies to encourage greater use of the town centre to maintain and enhance vitality and viability
- Continue to implement the projects included in the Signage Strategy *Town centre maps, Splash & Play signage, brown signs completed*
- Create a Tourism leaflet and consider how to promote the town *In progress*
- Encourage residents and visitors into the town centre through events such as the Big Lunch and the three-month temporary beach during the summer *Completed, very positive feedback from residents and visitors, achieved aspiration to increase footfall in town centre, both initiatives to be repeated in 2015. .*
- Support independent traders through initiatives such as Independents Day and summer bunting in the town centre *Completed.*
- Work with other stakeholders to implement the Town Centre Delivery Plan *Ongoing*
- Continue to work towards relocation of the town centre taxi rank and diversion of the buses from the High Street on market days *Ongoing; CBC reviewing options.*
