1. Improvements to signage and markings

The following works which were reported to Partnership Committee in December 2016 have now been completed in Leighton Buzzard and surrounding areas:

Birds Hill, Heath & Reach	Outside Co-Op and hse no 27	All L/W bays and Zig Zag markings needed repainting.
Bassett Rd, Leighton Buzzard	Opp hse no 19, lampposts no's 4 & 2	SYL signs needed replacing.
North Street, Leighton Buzzard	Outside Ocean Fish Bar	DYL needed repainting.
Church Road, Linlade	Opp hse no 2	SYL has been blacked out. Needed repainting.
Church Road, Linlade	Opp The Hunt Lodge / near lamppost no 3	SYL has a large gap / been blacked out, needed repainting.
Church Road, Linlade	Opp hse no 3a, 4 and Rochester Mews	L/W bay signs missing.
New Road, Linlade	Outside hse 27-29 and outside White Horse Pub	No L/W bay signs.
Waterlow Road, Linlade	Outside hse 48-50	Need sign for SYL.
High Street, Leighton Buzzard	Outside Wilkinson's	Need signage for D/B bays and loading only areas.

Rock Lane, Linlade	Outside hse no 41/lamppost no 6	SYL sign missing.

2. Performance

Over the last three months:

- 707 PCNs issued in Leighton Buzzard and 187 PCN's in Leighton Linslade.
- 1183 Visits from officers in Leighton Buzzard and 453 in Leighton Linslade.
- Brand new parking system refit for multi storey including the latest automatic number plate recognition(ANPR) technology procured and to be implemented in January. – *This will now be delayed until Feb/Mar due to waiting for BT to install some ADSL lines*
- Hockliffe being refitted and converted in to a pay on foot car park including the latest automatic number plate recognition(ANPR) technology to be implemented in January. – *This will now be delayed until Feb/Mar due to waiting for BT to install some ADSL lines*

Key highlights:

- Installation of new technology.

Key issues:

- Sign and line issues that have been prioritised and are being resolved (order has been placed and agreed see table above).
- We are looking to recruit further CEO's which will lead to increased patrols in both Leighton Buzzard and Leighton Linslade. –two new CEO's are in post a further 4 are being recruited .

Key Priorities over the next 3 months:

- West street Multi Storey refit with the latest automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) technology to be implemented in Feb/Mar.
- Hockliffe St Car Park conversion to a 'pay on foot' car park including ANPR technology to be implemented in Feb/Mar.
- Replace or reline the priority lines and signs across Leighton Linlade and Leighton Buzzard as part of a replacement program.
- New P&D machines to be installed in all remaining car park – due to begin in the middle of February.
- Development of an improved schools enforcement program. – This is now in place and records kept of what key priority schools have been visited and what action has been taken.

Key messages:

- There may be slight disruption to services when the new technology is installed at Hockliffe Street car park and West Street MSCP however this will be managed through forward planning. - Ongoing
