Project Details	<p>Physical long-term enhancement of out-side space attached to the group's property –developing a woodland and camping area thus broadening the activity offer and improving the quality of learning/experience by incorporating into the weekly programme – nature, forestry, science activities. This project will support the group's immediate beneficiaries and those uniformed groups who will be offered use of the campsite/woodland area.</p> <p>It is intended that this project activity will aid the group attract more young people into membership as well as volunteers as it will expand the activities available.</p> <p>With the addition of the trees, and the increased number of camps planned, they are already investing in their leadership training. Three of their leaders who don't currently have a camping permit will be completing their training on the weekend of 6th October '18.</p> <p>The project will commemorate the group's 110th birthday</p>
Outputs/Targets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 29x trees will be planted (Birch, Field Maple, Lime, Cherry, Apple & Plum) • 2x additional camps for the group organised on the site/ each year. <i>(Currently they only have one of four total camps held on the site each year. They will increase this number with two additional camps per year for the Group on the site. One of which is usually held remotely 15 miles away, however, with the new addition, the camp will be able to be held on the site.)</i> • The new tree area will enable additional badges to be gained. I have agreed with the leaders of each section that we will target the following; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Beavers – Gardeners badge – only 2 badges were awarded last year, this year we will be targeting a minimum of 15 badges gained ○ Cubs – Environmental conservation badge – No badges were awarded last year, this year we will be targeting a minimum of 15 badges gained ○ Scouts – Outdoor challenge – This is a badge we rarely complete as it requires services to a campsite for a duration. We will target 17 members this year to complete this section of the badge.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They will be able to promote the updated facility to other groups and will target a 20% uplift in camp site hires by other local uniformed groups, • They will target, programming and delivering an additional outside activity per term for each of the sections to encompass learning activities relating to nature, forestry and science – before end of March '19 and ongoing, • Improved wildlife and nature habitats
