The Committee will make decisions on any joint funding allocated to it.5. Influence and help shape strategies / plans that impact on the future viability of the town.6. Provide a forum for briefing Members of the Joint Committee on all key issues affecting the town, at the discretion of the Chairman and Vice Chairman.
