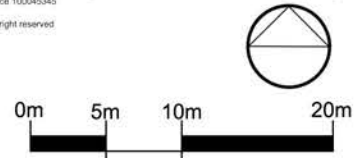

Plot frontage to provide year round structure with inclusion of low native clipped hedgerows and ornamental shrub planting. Fastigate tree species are incorporated within the street scene to help filter views within the development and add vertical structure.

Native tree and woodland shrub species planting in the southern open space reinforce buffer between the site and the surrounding areas.

1.2m wide timber edged hoggin footpath create a looped walk around the open space. Seating area with timber seating creates a communal area and meeting point.

A variety of wildflower grass mixes are used within the southern open space to help provide a range of wildlife habitats. The wildflower grass mixes which run through the space is used to enhance biodiversity across the development.
