### 1 RECOMMENDATION/S

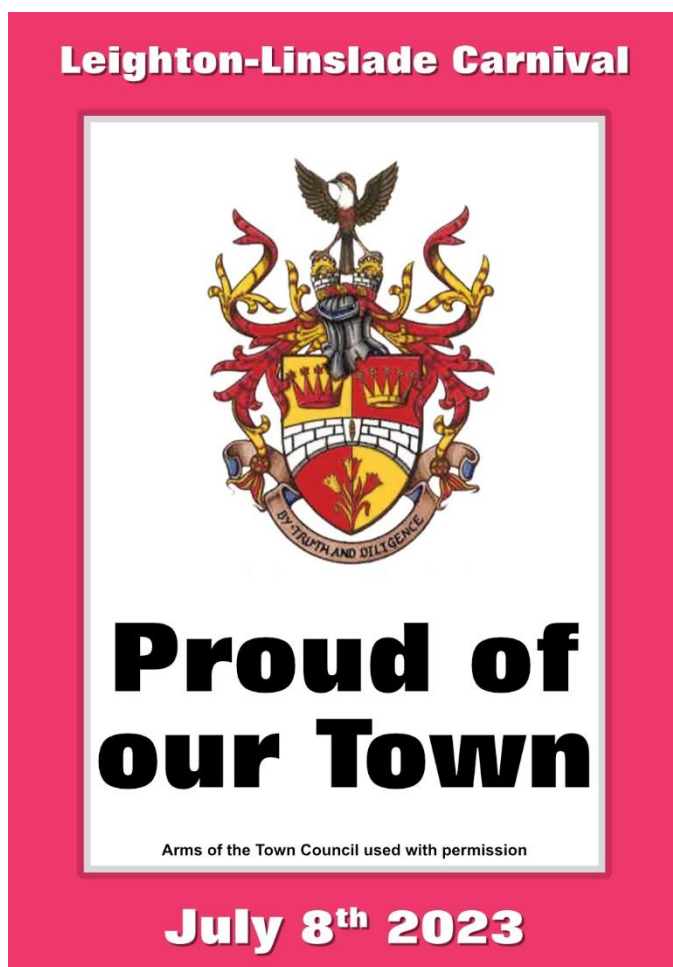
Should the Council be minded, the proposal is:

- 2.1 The Town Council has received a formal request from the Leighton-Linslade Carnival Committee regarding the use of the Town Council Arms for the 2023 Carnival.

- 2.2 The theme for the 2023 Carnival will be “Proud of our Town” and the Committee advises that having considered a range of options to try to convey this sentiment in an image, it was felt that use of the Town Council Arms would be most appropriate.
- 2.3 Advice has been sought from the College of Arms on this matter and the response received from the Chester Herald is that the arms may be used in this way if Council consent is given to do so and that this consent is acknowledged by the user.
